HOW JESUS BRINGS LIFE TO WHAT'S DEAD IN YOU John 11

John 11:25-26 (ESV)

"I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in Me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in Me shall never die..."

John 11:1-3 (ESV)

1 Now a certain man was ill, Lazarus of Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha. 2 It was Mary who anointed the Lord with ointment and wiped His feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was ill. 3 So the sisters sent to Him, saying, "Lord, he whom you love is ill."

John 11:4-5 (ESV)

"But when Jesus heard it He said, "This illness does not lead to death. It is for the glory of God, so that the Son of God may be glorified through it." Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus."

John 11:6 (ESV)

"So, when He heard that Lazarus was ill, He stayed two days longer in the place where He was."

John 11:7 (ESV)

"Then after this He said to the disciples, "Let us go to Judea again."

John 11:11-13 (ESV)

11 After saying these things, He said to them, "Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep, but I go to awaken him." 12 The disciples said to Him, "Lord, if he has fallen asleep, he will recover." 13 Now Jesus had spoken of his death, but they thought that he meant taking rest in sleep.

John 11:14-15 (ESV)

"Then Jesus told them plainly, "Lazarus has died, and for your sake I am glad that I was not there, so that you may believe. But let us go to him."

John 11:16 (ESV)

"So Thomas, called the Twin, said to his fellow disciples, "Let us also go, that we may die with Him."

John 11:20 (ESV)

"So when Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went and met Him, but Mary remained seated in the house."

John 11:17 (ESV)

"Now when Jesus came, He found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb four days."

John 11:39 (KJV)

"Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been dead four days."

John 11:21 (ESV)

"Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died."

John 11:22 (ESV)

"But even now I know that whatever You ask from God, God will give You."

John 11:23-24 (ESV)

"Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again." Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day."

John 11:25-26 (ESV)

"Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in Me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"

John 11:39 (ESV)
"Jesus said, "Take away the stone."

John 11:43 (ESV)
"He cried out with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out."

John 11:44 (ESV)

"The man who had died came out, his hands and feet bound with linen strips, and his face wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Unbind him, and let him go."

Mark 16:3 (ESV)

"Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?"

John 20:25 (ESV)

"...Unless I see in His hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into His side, I will never believe.

John 20:27 (ESV)

"[Jesus] said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see My hands; and put out your hand, and place it in My side. Do not disbelieve, but believe."

John 15:22 (ESV) "They have no excuse for their sin."

Isaiah 59:12 (NLT2)
"For our sins are piled up before God and testify against us."

Matthew 6:12 (ESV) "...forgive us our debts..."

"For the wages of sin is death..." Romans 6:23 (ESV)
"The payment for sin is death..." Romans 6:23 (GW)

Romans 6:23 (ESV)

"For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

1 John 1:8-9 (ESV)

"If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Ephesians 2:1-5 (ESV)

"And you were dead in the trespasses and sins ... But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved..."
