Nehemiah 10:1-29 (ESV)

1 “On the seals are the names of Nehemiah the governor, the son of Hacaliah, Zedekiah...
28 “The rest of the people... all who have knowledge and understanding, 29 join with their brothers, their nobles, and enter into a curse and an oath to walk in God’s Law that was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the LORD our Lord and His rules and His statutes.

“God paid a ransom to save you...and the ransom He paid was not mere gold or silver...
But He paid for you with the precious lifeblood of Christ, the sinless, spotless Lamb of God.”

Nehemiah 10:35-38 (ESV)

35 We obligate ourselves to bring the firstfruits...year by year, to the house of the LORD;
36 also to bring to the house of our God...the firstborn of our sons and of our cattle,
and the firstborn of our herds and of our flocks; 37 and to bring the first of our dough, and our contributions...
to the chambers of the house of our God; and to bring to the Levites the tithes from our ground...
